BlackHorse Golf Club

The BlackHorse Golf Club is a 36-hole daily fee golf course facility that was designed on 350 acres of flat land consisting of meadows, hardwood forests, and an abandoned sand quarry. Floodway and floodplain conditions existed as a result of Big Cypress Creek, which divides the north and south courses.

The front nine of the north course exemplifies the use of the meadowlands and the incorporation of our unique wetland designs. These wetland designs allow water to flow through, virtually eliminating stagnant water conditions, while providing an appealing wildlife habitat. Furthermore, the front nine on the north course is endowed with one of the old oxbows of Big Cypress Creek. We encouraged the indigenous plants such as palmettos to stabilize the banks and to create a different design feature. Four of the holes on the north course are out of the floodplain, and therefore we were able to showcase the homes of the BlackHorse Ranch.

The south course took on its own identity. The front nine begins in a mature forest, and works its way out into a meadow enriched environment with pristine lakes and lush marshes. The closing holes on the front nine return to the forest where they were carefully routed around the Big Cypress Creek. The back nine of the south course seems to have it all. Here the golfer finds several holes routed along an old abandoned sand quarry that features and expanse of sand hills and a majestic wetland that was planted with a variety of native wetland flora.

Throughout the 36-holes at BlackHorse Jacobsen Hardy Golf Course Design successfully combined several different environments making it one of the premier public golf course facilities in the state of Texas. BlackHorse was recently ranked #10 by T&L golf magazine as one of "Americas best 100 courses for \$100 or less".
