Cypress Ridge Golf Club

Cypress Ridge is an 18-hole daily fee golf course facility that was designed within a planned community. The site for Cypress Ridge consisted of 380 acres and was defined by mature cypress trees, panoramic vistas of the Pacific Ocean and rolling sand dunes. All of these characteristics combined truly make Cypress Ridge a golfers' paradise.

From the onset, Jacobsen Hardy Golf Course Design realized the tremendous potential that this piece of property presented. JHGCD and the developer took great pains to carefully route the golf course around the natural features at Cypress Ridge revealing and enhancing the beauty of the existing environment. In addition, the project team focused on the specific requirements of habitat enhancement, wildlife conservation, integrated pest management, and efficiency of water, waste and energy use. The fringe areas surrounding each hole are planted with native grasses, offering cover and food for existing wildlife. Approximately 40 species of reintroduced native plants provides a colorful backdrop to a spectacular golf course. Today Cypress Ridge is certified as a "Signature Sanctuary" through the prestigious Audubon International program.

The starting holes meander up and down the hillsides of the sand dunes. One hole in particular that has drawn plenty of attention is the short par-4 seventh. The green is driveable, however, it demands precision from those who try. Nonetheless, its the course's finishing holes that truly define its character. The par-4 16th is a dramatic, lengthy, uphill, dogleg left framed by cypress trees. Then its straight downhill on the 200 yard, par-3 17th before golfers tackle the par-5 finishing hole that concludes with a green guarded by a rock-lined lake.

Cypress Ridge has received rave reviews from golfers as well as the local community.
