Redstone Golf Club stands today where Eldorado Country Club once stood. El Dorado was originally designed by George Fazio in the early 1960's and was recognized as a good golf course for its time. However, El Dorado was situated next to the Greens Bayou which began to present drainage challenges that the existing golf course could not handle. In addition, the golf course features at El Dorado were beginning to deteriorate. Mowing patterns changed, original bunker edges were lost, trees matured - narrowing golf corridors and creating turf quality problems; simply put, time had taken its toll at El Dorado. So much so that it reached the point where it was beyond renovation. Because of a new residential development and a master plan that included long- range plans for multiple golf courses and a resort/conference center, the clubhouse was relocated and the golf course was rerouted. Certain environmental regulations and prevailing Harris County Flood Control regulations made the decision to redesign the course a "no-brainer".

The challenge presented was to develop a master drainage plan for a golf course sitting upon a flat site, one that would satisfy all the requirements of quality golf, as well as those requirements imposed by the various regulatory agencies involved. This was achieved through the development of interconnecting wetlands and lakes, and subsurface drainage to move water from the surrounding development through the golf course. By addressing the hydrological issues and applying our design philosophies the result is a truly great golf course facility that is sure to stand the test of time.

Redstone Golf Club has been selected by the PGA Tour as the new host for the Shell Houston Open, beginning 2003.
